Development of purpose-built Behaviour Support Withdrawal Centre (BSC)- asbestos removal, fit out, staffing of teacher aide and Guidance Officer (<i>Response to Intervention effect size 1.07*</i> , <i>Classroom management .52</i>)
Creation of Aspire classes (intensive literacy Value Added Program) for year 7 students (Comprehensive interventions effect size .77, <i>Direct instruction effect size .59*</i>)
Improving access to learning (ICT upgrade) and play environments to support engagement in learning and socialisation
