

Pre-requisites for Senior General Subjects in 2022



Year 11 students may choose a study a pathway that leads to the attainment of an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) score. Students who are planning to engage in tertiary study on completion of Year 12 must choose at least four "General" subjects in order to be ATAR eligible. Students not achieving a particular standard in a Year 10 subject may find the related General subjects in Years 11 and 12 difficult.

In order to ensure students are successful in Years 11 and 12, subject prerequisites must be met in order to enrol in General subjects. The subject prerequisites for the current Year 10 students are listed below. There are no pre-requisites for Applied (non-ATAR) or vocational education and training (VET) subjects.

Accounting (ACC)	C in Year 10 English
Agricultural Science (AGS)	B in Year 10 Science, C in Year 10 Maths and English
Ancient History (AHS)	C in Year 10 English and History
Business (BUS)	C in Year 10 English
Biology (BIO)	B in Year 10 Science and English
Chemistry (CHM)	B in Year 10 Science and English + must be studying General Maths or Mathematical Methods
Drama (DRA)	C in Year 10 English (Must have studied at least one Drama subject during Yr 9 and / or Yr 10 and achieved at least a C)
English (ENG)	B in Year 10 English
Food and Nutrition (FNU)	C in Year 10 English and Science
Health (HEA)	C in Year 10 HPE and C in English
Legal Studies (LEG)	C in Year 10 English
General Maths (MAG)	B in Core Maths
Mathematical Methods (MAM)	B or A in 10 Extension Maths or an A in Core Maths
Specialist Maths (MAS)	B or A in 10A Maths or an A in Core Maths
Music (MUS)	C in Year 10 English (Must have studied at least one Music subject during Yr 9 and / or Yr 10 and achieved at least a C). Must be able to play a musical instrument including the voice
Physical Education (PED)	C in Year 10 HPE or at least a C for Specialist Sport and a C in Year 10 English
Physics (PHY)	B in Year 10 Science and English + must be studying General Maths or Mathematical Methods
Visual Art (ART)	C in Year 10 English (Must have studied at least one Art subject during Yr 9 and / or Yr 10 and achieved at least a C)

Every effort will be made to provide students with an appropriate subject pathway which is dependent on the timetable and staffing considerations.

Any student who operates below the required level must negotiate with the relevant Head of Department who will make a recommendation to the Principal.

All subject selection decisions are at the discretion of the Principal.
